Blue Ribbon Senior Demonstrations will be competing for a trip to State 4-H Congress in July! The Blue Ribbon Jr. participants at age 13 will also have that choice.

- Initiative and ambition to gather information and supplies.
- Originality as they plan and organize the information.
- The ability to show and teach others.

Contest Descriptions and Additional Information

Please read through contest descriptions and tips. If you are going to be participating in that contest, please complete any additional required information.

Cloverbuds - Open to any Cloverbud member. There will be no time requirement for Cloverbuds, however, 1-3 minutes is suggested. Suggested presentation topics would include the 4-H pledge, a poem or nursery rhyme, a demonstration or an impromptu talk about an object.

Demonstration - Shows how to do something, step-by-step with a completed product at the end. Can be thought of as a "how to" guide.

Illustrated Talk - Conveys a concept or idea using visual aids, more of an "about" lesson.

(If you **show** someone how to do something, it is a demonstration. If you **tell** someone how to do something with the use of visual aids, it is an *illustrated talk*.)

- **No set time limit for the Junior Division**, however, a suggested time for Juniors is 3-7 minutes.
- **Juniors aged 13 who are hoping to attend Congress, must plan for 7-20 minutes**
- **Senior Division has a 7 minute minimum and 20 minute maximum**

- Be prepared to give your demonstration twice in case you are selected as a finalist
- The top boy and girl in each Junior group will advance to the final run-off if numbers warrant

Speech - This is a way of communicating an idea, thought or point of view *without* using visual aids.

Impromptu Speech - A random topic is given and presenters have 3 minutes to think about what & how they are going to give a speech on the topic.

Members may choose any topic they wish. **Jr. speeches must be 3-7 minutes in length, 13 year olds who are hoping to attend Congress will have a 5-7 minute requirement. Sr. speeches are to be 5-7 minutes long.** In the event of a tie in the Senior Division, an impromptu speech will be used to break that tie. **NO VISUAL AIDS** may be used, but note cards are acceptable.
