



Outstanding 4-H Volunteer Award

The Richland County 4-H Council has established the following criteria for this award:

1. Volunteer must be a current 4-H volunteer as of March 31st.
2. Any current 4-H member or volunteer may nominate an individual for this award.
3. Nomination forms must be submitted to the Extension Office by October 1st.
4. The Executive Council will select the recipients of the awards.
5. No more than 5 recipients will be named each year.
6. An individual is not eligible to receive this award more than once within eight years.
7. Recipients will be announced at Achievement Day and will receive an award decided on
by the Leaders Council.
